**PSA Contest FAQs**

- 1. What are my chances of winning?**
  - a. Odds of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries.
  
- 2. If I purchase or download copyrighted music legally, can I use it in my video?**
  - a. Unfortunately, no. If music has been copyrighted by another individual and you do not have permission, you cannot use it in your PSA. All music must be original or in the public domain. All entries using copyrighted material will be disqualified.
  
- 3. If I can't use copyrighted music, what CAN I use?**
  - a. There are several free programs available online that you can use to create your own music. Examples: Fruity Loops, LMMS – Linux Multimedia Studio, Temper from AngryRedPlanet.com, Garage Band (for macs). OR, use music that is in the public domain.
  
- 4. What is the public domain?**

- 5. What pictures are safe to use?**
  - a. Just like music, if the photo isn't yours, it can't be used – UNLESS – you purchase the image from istockphoto.com, Getty images, fotolia.com, etc.
  
- 6. Does it matter if I show brand name products like food or alcohol?**
  - a. Please use discretion in this area as we do not want to show any brand name product in a negative or positive light.
  
- 7. How will I know who won?**
  - a. A CollegeResponse representative will contact the winner within two weeks after the deadline. All colleges and universities using the National Eating Disorder Screening Program will be notified of the winner.
